Meeting Minutes

- I. Pre-Fencing
 - We have requested a bid for fencing the outer portion of the fence, the introduction area, and the 1-acre playground area.
 - This pre-fencing, will allow for scheduled fundraising events to take place to raise the funds necessary to install signs and remaining fence for us to proceed with our Grand Opening to the general public.
- II. Scheduled Fundraising Events
 - Scheduled Play Groups
 - Training Events and/or Trials
 - Fundraising Events (Eggstravegganza, Barktoberfest, etc.)
- III. Creation of a new Monitoring Committee
 - This committee will offer monitoring of the park during specific park hours to assist in enforcing the rules and regulations that will be posted on permanent signs prior to our Grand Opening.
 - Members of this committee will be “armed” with monitoring devices to ensure and encourage proper play between canines.
 - Monitoring volunteers will wear either t-shirts, baseball caps, or arm bands for identification purposes. The type of identification has not been determined.
- IV. Would Omaha like to have the opportunity for their dog(s) to join a dog park membership?
 - Owners would provide proof of vaccinations and pay a small annual fee to help defray the costs of park maintenance.
 - Dog members would receive a special tag to display prominently on their collar. Members with advanced obedience certifications would be eligible for a unique collar tag!
